Our Beliefs...

We believe in meeting the *personal/social needs* of students by:

- Facilitating the development of critical time management skills for students
- Providing students opportunities to learn to effectively work cooperatively within a team
- Fostering work readiness skills, such as being on time, completing a task, face-to-face communication skills, appropriate Language, and general etiquette

We believe in meeting the *career preparation needs* of students by:

- Providing exposure to career options and an understanding of the path necessary to enter a given career
- Providing opportunities for career exploration, such as career and interest inventories, job shadowing, and internships
- Assisting students to select courses based on career interests to prepare them for a given career or program of higher education
- Developing critical technological skills and aptitudes
- Making a direct connection between school experience and career preparation

We believe *that engaging parents/guardians & community members*:

- Is our responsibility
- Requires counselors to build relationship with parents/guardians, students, and community members
- Is essential for the academic, career, and personal and social development of students
- Is accomplished by providing resources and support for parents/guardians to be meaningfully involved in their child's college and/or career planning process
- Can effectively occur through educating parents/guardians and actively soliciting feedback from them regarding guidance services and programs

We believe a *developmentally appropriate school counseling program*:

- Prepares every student for life beyond high school
- Challenges and encourages the positive development of students
- Must be age and grade appropriate
- Addresses the social and emotional development of students at each of their developmental stages
- Assists students with developing coping strategies and problem-solving skills
- Provides developmentally appropriate career awareness and preparation
- Promotes good citizenship
