STUDENT DROP OFF/PICK UP LOCATION FOR PARENTS WHO DRIVE STUDENTS TO SCHOOL

ALL STUDENT DROP-OFF FROM 7:00 - 7:20 AM AND PICK-UP FROM 2:00 - 2:20 PM WILL BE AT THE MAIN BUILDING LOOP OFF FOUNTAIN AVENUE

Parents should enter the campus from Fountain Avenue ONLY and proceed through the loop in front of the Main Building. School buses will NOT use the Main building loop for drop-off or pick-up of students.

Please adhere to the following to ensure the safety of our students:

- Only discharge students once safely stopped in the main building loop.
- Students may only use the designated crosswalk to the Hopkins building once being discharged at the Main building loop. Students should remain on the side walk until they reach the Hopkins building.
- Cutting through the student parking area is strictly prohibited.
- ◆ All students drop-off, from 7:00 7:20 AM and pick-up from 2:00 2:20 PM, must occur at the Main building loop regardless of which building your child attends classes.
- It is strongly recommended that you have your child utilize school busing if eligible or leave ample time in the morning for drop off due to traffic.
